## **IoE INITIATIVE FOR PROMOTION PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS: CALL FOR PROPOSALS**

### **BACKGROUND**

One of the main commitments made by the University and also mandated by the GoI in the Institution of Eminence programme is that the University will generate 33% of the grant awarded to it through various internal resource and revenue generation schemes. The imperative is that revenue generation should not impact the University's mandate of social equity, justice and empowerment. It is also envisaged that such programmes will increase student enrolment, enhance visibility of the University nationally and internationally, improve research output and enable the culture of translational research through innovation and entrepreneurship in addition to generating revenue.

One of the initiatives of the IoE to enable translational research through innovation and entrepreneurship is the promotion of public-private partnerships. The objective of this scheme is to encourage industries, NGOs and other private entities to invest in collaborative translational research, creation of think-tanks, new infrastructure aimed at translational and emerging areas of research, creation of new facilities for teaching and research, funding fellowships to PG and PhD students, offering internships to PG students and funding and instituting named chair Professorships.

Proposals are invited from academic units and faculty members in the [prescribed format](#):

*Deadline: This is a rolling call valid until the end of the tenure of IoE. Proposals will be considered as and when they are received.*

### **General guidelines**

1. It is expected that the UoH team and the private entity will enter into a non-disclosure agreement followed by an MoU in which details of IP and revenue sharing are elucidated, prior to sanction of the project.
2. The project either in full or in part should not be under consideration by any other funding agency.
3. If financial assistance is granted, the project coordinator(s) from UoH will take the complete responsibility to submit project completion report, statement of expenditure / utilization certificate.
4. The investigating teams should acknowledge IoE support if the work is published in any scientific and technical journals.
5. The project coordinator of UoH must take prior approval of the competent authority before proceeding on long leave during the tenure of the project.
6. The maximum duration of the project is two years.
7. Any other guidelines issued by UoH regarding this scheme will be followed.
